The Cannes Film Festival

The Cannes Film Festival is the world's most famous film festival and is held in May each year in Cannes, in the south of France. It was held for the first time from September 20 to October 5, 1946, in the coastal (沿海的) city of Cannes. This festival attracts the attention of all the media (媒体) and receives the visits of important artists, Hollywood actors and directors as well as a large number of film makers.

French Open

The Roland Garros Stadium plays host to the Grand Slam Tennis Tournament (联赛). It takes place in Paris at the end of May every year. Only the best tennis players around the world can take part in this tournament.

Nice Jazz Festival

Toronto in Canada is one of those cities that people visit and then dream of living in. It's large, but not too large; prosperous (繁荣的), but not expensive.
